We are excited about our Rockpool visit with a hands on educational experience provided by knowledgeable Marine Rangers. The children will be encouraged to come up to the Rockpool to handle the creatures and ask questions!

Some of the creatures your children will meet and be able to touch include:

- Common Shore Crab (not touchable)
 - Hermit Crabs
- Spider Crabs.
- Common, Spiny and Sun Starfish.
- British Anemones.
 - Shellfish
