Reminder of Covid Absence <u>Procedures</u>

The latest school guidance from the local authority is that anyone (including children) who test positive for Covid-19, are strongly advised to stay at home for 5 days. After 5 days, it is recommended that a lateral flow test is taken, followed by another the next day. If both are negative, and your child does not have a temperature, they can safely return to school.
