100 Club Rules

Purpose

The purpose of the 100 club is to raise funds. The money will be paid into the PTFA bank account and used to meet funding requests from the school, providing equipment, resources and opportunities for pupils.

Rules

- 1. For a cost of £2 per month (i.e. per draw) you will be allocated one number between one and 100.
- 2. A draw will be made every month with one winner.
- 3. The prizes will total 50% of the annual income or a maximum £1200 per annum (£100 per month).
- 4. This will be apportioned as one prize per month totalling 50% of the monthly income, with a maximum of £100.
- 5. The 100 club is a small society lottery and is open to all provided they are over the age of 16.
- 6. Payments must be made by standing order, bank transfer, cheque or cash preferably annually.
- 7. One month's notice to made in writing to the Friends of Brabins School is required for cancellation.
- 8. Member's numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date.
- 9. If a member has no valid reason for missing a payment, their number may be sold to someone on the reserve list.
- 10. The draw will be made by the PFTA Chairperson (or their allocated deputy) on the last Friday of each month. If this should land on a public holiday, then the draw will take place on the next working day.
- 11. The winning cheque will be posted to the address on your membership application within one week of the draw.
- 12. The name and numbers for each month's winners will be posted in the school newsletter, PTFA Facebook page and on the school website.
- 13. The 100 club will be run by the PTFA. In case of any dispute the decision of the committee is final.
- 14. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 100 club if his/her subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of one month.
- 15. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into PTFA funds after six months.
