# <u>Swimming Information for Y3/4 - Autumn Term 2025</u>

**Swimwear** must be suitable for the purpose. Girls must wear a one-piece swimming costume and boys must wear swimming trunks or appropriate shorts.

Goggles will be allowed when needed i.e. when chemicals in the water may adversely affect eyes. Pupils who wish to wear goggles must have a permission slip signed by their parent / guardian / carer (included on the Consent form). Long Hair must be tied back. Children can wear swimming hats.

**Jewellery / watches** must be removed prior to the swimming lesson. Please be advised that earnings cannot be worn for swimming lessons.

It is advisable that any pupils that wish to have body piercing do so at the beginning of the school summer holidays. Earrings cannot be worn for any swimming or PE lessons/competitions.
