**Topic – ‘On the move’ -Transport**  
Linked to children’s interest.

**Term:** Summer 2<sup>nd</sup> Half term 2025

### Getting Started

**On the move topic – linked to the children’s interest** – Start our topic through reading ‘The Naughty bus’ during the story the children will be asked questions about what happened. We will look at how the story is presented in the book looking at the different fonts. The children will retell the story in their own words. Introduce information book ‘Wheels, wings and other things’, focusing on different types of transport from the past and present, discussing the differences and similarities between them. The children will have the opportunity to look at and create their own map linked to their journey to school and the school’s surroundings

### **Computing**
