PE and uniform reminders!

A few reminders ahead of the new school year!

-Children should wear black shoes- not boots.

-Jewellery should not be worn other than small stud type earrings. If there are plans to get ears pierced, please note that the summer holidays are a good opportunity as **earrings need to be removed** for all PE sessions.

-Nail varnish should not be worn.

-Long hair should be tied back. Headlice is very frustrating for everyone; if hair is tied back, it can help to minimise transmission.

-Water bottles need to be non-spill and not made of glass.

Swimming Information for Y3/4 - Autumn Term 2025

Swimwear must be suitable for the purpose. Girls must wear a one-piece swimming costume and boys must wear swimming trunks or appropriate shorts.

Goggles will be allowed when needed i.e. when chemicals in the water may adversely affect eyes. Pupils who wish to wear goggles must have a permission slip signed by their parent / guardian / carer (included on the Consent form). **Long Hair** must be tied back. Children can wear swimming hats.

Jewellery / watches must be removed prior to the swimming lesson. Please be advised that earrings cannot be worn for swimming lessons.

It is advisable that any pupils that wish to have body piercing do so at the beginning of the school summer holidays. Earrings cannot be worn for any swimming or PE lessons/competitions.
