School Attendance

Good attendance is key to your child being able to fulfil their potential and make good progress in school. One of the most important ways a parent can support the education of their child as well as their social, emotional and academic development is to ensure they attend every day and on time.

At Brabin's School, we aim to encourage and assist all pupils to achieve excellent levels of attendance and punctuality. Our target for all pupils is to achieve 96% attendance over the course of a school year, with no unauthorised absences. Poor school attendance, and/or regular late arrival, interrupts the continuity of learning and, consequently, limits their academic and social progress in school.

Ensuring your child's regular attendance at school is a parent/carer's legal responsibility and we want to ensure that we are doing all that we can do to support you. If there is anything you would like to discuss relating to attendance concerns, please speak to Mrs Wallace.
